The first seven questions below are required for this reflection; there are also five optional questions listed below. This is more of an informal assignment, so don't worry about sentence structure or grammar/mechanics (although please try to *always* use upper-case "I" vs. "i" when referring to yourself – this is a good habit to get into, no matter the stakes).

I'm expecting about 1.5-2 pages single-spaced for this (typed, of course). Don't think too much – just write!! I'm looking for honesty about your own experiences as well as what you think you learned or gained from this...



I. Required questions for your Reflection

(...brief answers are okay as long as I know what questions you're addressing)

- a. What was it like working in a group, in general?
- b. What was it like working in *your particular group* on *this particular project*?
- c. From working in this group, what did you learn about yourself and about working in groups?
- d. Is there anything you would do differently next time you're assigned a group project?
- e. Did you like the work and the thinking that was required for a visual-oriented project? How was this project different from written projects you've completed?
- f. If you were entering WRT 104 all over again, would you want more digital/visual projects? (Video production, blogging, vlogging, website building, digital storytelling, photo essays, etc)
- g. What was your favorite part of this project, and what was your least favorite part of this project?

II. Optional Questions to Address

- a. Was the work distribution hard to decide on? In the end, was the work evenly distributed?
- b. Do you feel like you carried your group through this project? OR – do you feel like you could have done more to help?
- c. A collaborative project is a department requirement for this course (not my personal decision, in other words), do you think you gained any real-life skills from this?
- d. In evaluating your group members, did you feel obligated to give them higher grades than they deserved, or do you think you were completely fair?
- e. WHAT ELSE?? Is there anything else you want me to know or think I should address in future projects?
